

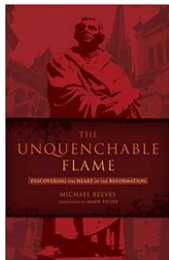


Below you will find the mandatory summer reading assignment along with recommendations for course preparations.

1. Name
2. Years alive

4. Their specific contributions to the Reformation either before, during, or after
5. **You must** label evidence of their contributions. You may highlight, underline, or bold specific speeches, publications, or actions.

After you have completed the above, provide a two-paragraph analysis of the book. Include your own analysis on the quality of the book, the content provided, and the significance of the Reformation on European history.
