## All Tracks Will Complete:

### English Courses:

- English III, English III Honors, or AP English Language and Composition
- English IV, English IV Honors, or AP English Literature and Composition

### Social Studies Courses:

- World History, World History Honors, or AP World History
- U.S. History, U.S. History Honors, or AP U.S. History
- Government Honors I and II OR AP US Government and Politics OR AP Comparative Government

### World Language Courses:

- 4 credits in a single world language OR
- 3 credits in a single world language **and** 1 credit in a second world language OR
- Demonstrated fluency in a language other than English
