Job Description: To be a coach in the SIMA Pre-Academy age groups U8 to U13 and contribute to the daily operations of the program. Engage with kids and motivate them to learn to love the game of soccer. Demonstrate that the safety and well-being of all participants is a priority and having a pedagogical approach over competing during the sessions and games. This position is a stipend coach position and does not receive full time employee benefits.

Responsibilities:

- The Soccer Institute at Montverde Academy (SIMA) Pre-Academy coaches are expected to follow and support the mission of Montverde Academy as an academic institution.
- Prepare and maintain training sessions according to SIMA methodology.
- Conduct and supervise all practices.
- Enforce student policies and procedures.
- Be a role model for students.
- Ensure uniforms and equipment are well kept and accounted for.
- Communicate issues/concerns with appropriate staff.
- Communicate and meet with parents as necessary.
- Follow game day responsibilities.

Qualifications and Skills:

- Studies and/or experience in soccer, physical sciences, or similar activities.
- Enthusiasm to work with children ages 7-12 and become a specialized coach in early stages
- Excellent skills in organization, communication, and student supervision
- Demonstrates strong character in relationships with students, parents, and co-workers
- CPR certification

Physical Requirements:

- Position will involve mobility within the campus facilities and various sites including game locations.
